

# Bone Wax®

Sterile Bonewax 12 x 2.5 g



## Description

Bone wax is a mixture of beeswax, kerosene and isopropyl palmitate, a warfare softening agent. It is opaque and has a wax-like odor. It is indicated for the control of bleeding from bone surfaces during surgical procedures.

It achieves local hemostasis of the bone by acting as a mechanical barrier (but ering). It has no biochemical action and is not absorbable. It is available in sterile form in individual aluminum envelopes, each containing 2.5 g and packed in an individually sealed overwrap. The surgical wax is sterilized by gamma radiation.

Packages should be opened just prior to use to minimize the possibility of contamination and overdrying and should be used immediately. The surgical wax should not be resterilized or subjected to excessive heat.
